French 2 is a continuation of learning some basic topics such as greetings, describing people, hobbies, likes, dislikes, family relationship, celebrations, etc.

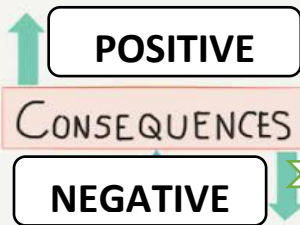

Instructional Topics

Unit 1: Ma Famille

15 periods, 90 minutes in length

Describe friends and family
Converse about likes and dislikes.
Describe the culture of Paris, France.

Unit 2: Celebrations & Holidays

15 periods, 90 minutes in length

Describe French celebrations and holidays
Converse about cultural facts as related to celebrations and holidays from other French speaking countries
Describe the culture of Quebec, Canada, West African countries.

Unit 3: Fruits and Vegetables

15 periods, 90 minutes in length

Tell what fruits and vegetables people like to eat and how often
Express preferences while talking about fruits and vegetables
Talk about shopping fruits and vegetables as related to specific stores

Unit 4: Allons en Ville

15 periods, 90 minutes in length

Create a plan for a day of shopping and services in the city.
Ask for and give directions.
Use *savoir vs connaître* & Form a question using inversion.
Analyze the culture of the Midi region of France.
