 School of Education Teach Residency Program. Transcripts for initial evaluation must be uploaded here.
- After transcripts have been reviewed and provisionally accepted by UMSL, participants may apply to the Teacher-in-Residency job posting on the Hazelwood School District website <u>here</u>.
- Participants must pass the Missouri Content Assessment (MoCA) to be considered for a district teaching placement. More information on the MoCA can be found https://missouri.teach.org/
