

HSD TEACHER IN RESIDENCY PROGRAM FOR SUPPORT STAFF

Hazelwood School District and the University of Missouri-St. Louis (UMSL) College of Education is now offering a comprehensive alternative certification program. UMSL Teach Residency participants can receive an alternative teaching license/certificate that permits them to perform as full-time classroom teachers of record while completing required coursework to earn full state certification.

Criteria for selection includes:

- Zero years of full-time lead teaching experience.
- Hold a bachelor's degree (any area) with minimum 2.5 cum GPA.
- Apply and be accepted into University of Missouri-St. Louis (UMSL) School of Education Teach Residency Program. Transcripts for initial evaluation must be uploaded [here](#).
- After transcripts have been reviewed and provisionally accepted by UMSL, participants may apply to the Teacher-in-Residency job posting on the Hazelwood School District website [here](#).
- Participants must pass the Missouri Content Assessment (MoCA) to be considered for a district teaching placement. More information on the MoCA can be found [here](#).


