Behavior Tips for Surviving the Holidays

- ★ When hosting holiday parties at home, try to pre-plan some activities for the kids to do like decorating a big box to make a gingerbread house that they can play in when finished. Structured and organized activities leaves less time for chaos and fighting.
- ★ Try to keep routines like naps, bedtime, mealtime, etc. as consistent as possible.
- ★ Talk with your children about behavior expectations prior to attending holiday events. Remind them periodically of those expectations and praise them when they are following the rules.
- ★ Know when your child has "had enough" and take them home before they have a behavior meltdown rather than dealing with the tantrum after the fact.
